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Short Description of IPSE Programme : The Certificate in Social Citizenship is a one-year course. Classes take place 3 days per week from September to April, followed by a 3-month work

placement. Students develop skills to promote self-reliance and independence.

The course is underpinned by a rights-based agenda, and provides opportunities for co-learning between students with and without disabilities, for mutual benefit. This promotes awareness raising and reciprocal learning.

Detailed Description of Programme : What Is The Certificate in Social Citizenship (CSC)?

The Certificate in Social Citizenship (CSC) is a one-year part-time programme. Students develop skills to promote increased self-reliance and independence and this allows them to become more involved in all aspects of life.

The programme is underpinned by the values of respect, recognition of diversity and inclusivity, and is informed by a rights-based agenda.

The course provides opportunities for interaction between CSC students and students on other university programmes. This creates spaces for awareness-raising and reciprocal learning, enriches the university as a whole, and enhances campus and community engagement.

What Will Students Be Studying?

1. Core Group Modules

These modules are taken only with other students from the Certificate in Social Citizenship.

Subjects include:

- Using information technology
- Communication skills
- Group work skills
- Social and cultural studies
- Rights and relationships

2. Co-Learning Modules

These modules are taken with students from other courses around the university.

Students choose one of the following subject areas:

- Developing creativity - music and drama
- Promoting rights and advocacy
- Creating accessible and inclusive spaces
- Supporting health and wellbeing
- Becoming a global citizen

3. Internship

Students spend 3 months on placement doing work experience.

What Will Students Do On Campus?

College life is not just about studying! There are lots of interesting Clubs and Societies which CSC students are welcome to join. Students are encouraged to explore activities that interest them, and every effort is made to support them in participating in the clubs and societies they choose. Some of our students are very successful Special Olympians who balance their sporting lives with their studies.

International Summer School

The Certificate in Social Citizenship team hosts an International Summer School every year. This week-

long programme provides an inclusive and immersive introduction to Irish cultural, social, and historical life for adults with intellectual disabilities visiting from abroad. The Summer School provides supported opportunities for CSC students and visiting international students to share an enriching, intercultural experience.
